

FIRE SERVICES ORDINANCE (Chapter 95)

ORDER MADE BY THE REGISTERED FIRE SERVICE INSTALLATION
CONTRACTORS DISCIPLINARY BOARD

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Board appointed by the Chief Executive under regulation 9 of the Fire Service (Installation Contractors) Regulations (the 'Regulations'), subsidiary legislation of the Fire Services Ordinance, Chapter 95, Laws of Hong Kong, was satisfied after a due inquiry held on 10 May 2017 in accordance with regulation 10 of the Regulations, that HUI Ham-so trading as Sun Tai Company, being a Class 2 registered Fire Service Installation Contractor, on 20 July 2016 was convicted by a court sitting at Kowloon City Magistrates' Courts (Case No. KCS 21623/2016) of contravening Regulation 7(1) of the Fire Service (Installations and Equipment) Regulations, made under the Fire Services Ordinance, Chapter 95, and such an offence will make his continued inclusion in the register of fire service installation contractors prejudicial to the due administration of the Fire Services Ordinance.

It is further notified that pursuant to regulation 10(2)(a) of the Regulations, the said Disciplinary Board ordered that the name of HUI Ham-so trading as Sun Tai Company be removed from the register of fire service installation contractors in Class 2 for a period of 14 days, and the order was to take effect from 22 June 2017 to 5 July 2017.
