Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 60102100/D3_GAZ/101, 60102100/D3_GAZ/102 and 60102100/D3_GAZ/103 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) construction of Road D3 (Metro Park Section) of approximately 1.1 kilometres long including at grade carriageways with associated at grade footpaths, elevated carriageways with associated elevated footpaths, depressed carriageways and vehicular underpass:
- (ii) construction of Road L12d of approximately 50 metres (m) long with associated at grade footpath;
- (iii) construction of at grade footpath, central medians/traffic islands, amenity areas and pedestrian crossings;
- (iv) construction of a landscaped deck structure of approximately 400 m long above Road D3 (subject to detailed design);
- (v) temporary closure and modification of roads which are under PWP Item No. 469CL Kai Tak Development—Infrastructure at North Apron Area of Kai Tak Airport Stage 4 Infrastructure Works, including sections of the carriageways, footpaths, central medians/ traffic islands and pedestrian crossings of Road D2 and Road L6, as shown on Plan No. 60102100/D3_GAZ/101;
- (vi) temporary closure and modification of roads which are under PWP Item No. 7711CL (Part) Kai Tak Development—Stage 2 Infrastructure Works for Developments at the Southern Part of the Former Runway, including sections of the carriageways, footpaths, central medians/traffic islands and landscaped deck structure integrated with noise barrier of Road D3A, as shown on Plan No. 60102100/D3_GAZ/103;
- (vii) temporary closure of sections of the carriageways, footpaths, central medians/traffic islands, pedestrian crossings and landscaped deck structure integrated with noise barrier; and
- (viii) ancillary works including construction of outfalls, as well as drainage, water, utilities and landscaping works.
