ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONE ON QUEEN'S ROAD CENTRAL, CENTRAL

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 21 July 2017, the western kerbside lane of Queen's Road Central from a point about 50 metres west of its junction with D'Aguilar Street to a point about 85 metres west of the same junction will be designated as a restricted zone 24 hours daily.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except goods vehicles for loading or unloading from 9.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon, from 2.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m. and from 7.00 p.m. to 7.00 a.m. of the following day daily, franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zone on the above road section will be rescinded.
