SEWERAGE AT PO TOI O

(Notice under section 8(2) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation)

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection proposes to execute the sewerage works within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 382770/WPCR/2.6/001 and 382770/WPCR/2.6/002 (the 'Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed sewerage works is as follows:----

- (i) construction of about 860 metres of gravity sewers and associated manholes within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans;
- (ii) construction of about 464 metres of twin pressurized mains and associated chambers within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans;
- (iii) construction of about 385 metres of submarine outfall by Horizontal Directional Drilling method and associated diffuser within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans;
- (iv) construction of a sewage treatment plant within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans; and
- (v) ancillary works including temporary closure and reinstatement of carriageways, footpaths and open space.
