# NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A SLIP ROAD FROM LIN CHEUNG ROAD TO CROSS-BORDER COACH TERMINUS AT MTR KOWLOON STATION AND A SECTION OF WILL CHEUNG ROAD

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Acting Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 16 August 2017 (the 'Order'), authorized:—

- (I) the temporary closure of the slip road from Lin Cheung Road to Cross-Border Coach Terminus at MTR Kowloon Station, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered XRL/G45/0021/4; and
- (II) the temporary partial closure of the section of Wui Cheung Road between Canton Road and Wui Man Road, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered XRL/G45/0021/4.

during the period from 21 September 2017 to 31 March 2018 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Hong Kong Section of Guangzhou-Shenzhen-Hong Kong Express Rail Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

The roads to be affected

(a) The slip road from Lin Cheung Road to The carriageway widths will be

(b) The section of Wui Cheung Road Pa between Canton Road and Wui Man Road, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered of XRL/G45/0021/4.

temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the underpass of Lin Cheung Road and the pedestrian subway connecting the terminus of the Hong Kong Section of Guangzhou-Shenzhen-Hong Kong Express Rail Link and MTR Kowloon Station.

Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the terminus of the Hong Kong Section of Guangzhou-Shenzhen-Hong Kong Express Rail Link and its connection with the pedestrian subway at MTR Austin Station.
