ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON ABERDEEN TOWN CENTRE

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 15 September 2017, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Aberdeen Main Road from a point about 40 metres west of its junction with Chengtu Road, to a point about 10 metres east of the same junction; and the southern kerbside lane of Aberdeen Main Road from its junction with Lok Yeung Street, to a point about 15 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the section of Tung Sing Road between Aberdeen Main Road and Lok Yeung Street;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Chengtu Road north from its junction with Lok Yeung Street;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Chengtu Road from its junction with Aberdeen Main Road to a point about 15 metres south of the same junction; and
- (e) the whole section of the northern kerbside lane of Lok Yeung Street.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zone on the above road sections will be rescinded.
