

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in duplicate are invited for **Contract No. GE/2016/10, Landslip Prevention and Mitigation Programme, 2012, Package D, Landslip Prevention and Mitigation Works in Lantau Island**. The works include upgrading of 7 government slopes and retaining walls and natural terrain mitigation works to 6 natural hillside catchments in Lantau Island. The works are scheduled to commence in February 2018 and will take about 30 months to complete.

Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board, and placed in the Government Logistics Department Tender Box situated on the Ground Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before 12.00 noon on Friday, 27 October 2017. Late tenders will not be accepted.

If a black rainstorm warning signal or a tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above is in effect at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 27 October 2017, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the first working day after the black rainstorm warning signal has ceased to be in effect or the tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 is lowered. An announcement of change will be made through the radio.
