

ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)
(Notice under section 18)

PROPOSED ROAD WORKS FOR THE FUTURE WEST RAIL
TSUEN WAN WEST STATION TW5 PROPERTY DEVELOPMENT

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has ordered under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance') to close temporarily a section of the existing carriageway and a section of the existing landscaping area at the westbound of Tsuen Wan Road near Tai Chung Road Interchange within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. RDM0558 ('the Plan') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, and as amended by Amendment Plan No. RDM0558a ('the Amendment Plan') and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto, and as further amended by Second Amendment Plan No. RDM0558b ('the Second Amendment Plan') and described in the second amendment scheme annexed thereto. The Plan and scheme were referred to in G.N. 8694 published on 24 December 2008 and 2 January 2009. The Amendment Plan and amendment scheme were referred to in G.N. 4630 published on 22 July 2011 and 29 July 2011. The Second Amendment Plan and second amendment scheme were referred to in G.N.5457 published on 30 September 2016 and 7 October 2016. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that from 1 October 2017 to 30 September 2018, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the section of the existing carriageway and the section of the existing landscaping area to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve the road works for the future West Rail Tsuen Wan West Station TW5 Property Development.

A copy of the order, the Plan, the Amendment Plan and the Second Amendment Plan may be inspected by members of the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—

This notice will be affixed on or near the affected carriageway and landscaping area on 22 September 2017.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing, which can be submitted *via* one of the following means, before the expiration of one year from the date of closure, extinction, modification or restriction:—

- (1) by post or by hand to the Transport and Housing Bureau's Drop-in Box No. 6 located at the 2nd Floor Entrance, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong. The box is available for use between 8.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. from Monday to Friday (except public holidays);
