ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN KOWLOON CITY

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 22 September 2017 to 14 October 2017, the following road sections in Kowloon City will continue to be temporarily designated restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Prince Edward Road West eastbound from its junction with Waterloo Road to a point about 125 metres west of the same junction; and
- (b) the section of Waterloo Road northbound from its junction with Prince Edward Road West to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones has been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
