LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ORDINANCE (Chapter 159)

ORDER THAT A SOLICITOR BE SUSPENDED FROM PRACTISING
YU CHUN LEE AMENA

In accordance with section 12(2) of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Chapter 159), I hereby give notice that on 15 September 2017 a Solicitors Disciplinary Tribunal ('the Tribunal') found a complaint against YU Chun Lee Amena ('Ms. YU') proved. The complaint was that Ms. YU on 16 January 2014 acted unbecoming a solicitor in contrary to common law. The Tribunal ordered that:—

- (a) Ms. YU be censured.
- (b) Ms. YU be suspended from practice for one and a half year from the clerk to the Tribunal's filing of the order with the Registrar of the High Court.
- (c) The costs of and incidental to these proceedings, including the costs of the Applicant in investigating into the matter and in prosecuting the complaint and the costs of the clerk to the Tribunal be borne and paid by Ms. YU, such costs to be taxed if not agreed, on party-to-party basis.

The Order of the Tribunal dated 15 September 2017 was filed by the Clerk to the Tribunal with the Registrar on 15 September 2017.
