## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN KOWLOON CITY

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 1 October 2017 to 31 December 2017, the following road sections in Kowloon City will continue to be temporarily designated restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Nga Tsin Wai Road from a point about 15 metres east of its junction with Nam Kok Road to a point about 5 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the section of Prince Edward Road West from its junction with Nam Kok Road to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction; and
- (c) the section of Nam Kok Road between Prince Edward Road West and Nga Tsin Wai Road (except the lay-by).

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones has been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
