Late tenders will not be accepted. If a black rainstorm warning signal or tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above is in effect for any duration between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on the tender closing date as stated above, the closing time of this tender will be deferred to 12.00 noon on the following working day (i.e. except Saturday, Sunday and public holiday) after the black rainstorm warning signal has ceased to be in effect or the tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above is lowered. All time references are Hong Kong time.

Open tendering is adopted. All interested contractors/suppliers/service providers are invited to tender.
