ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONE ON QUEEN'S ROAD WEST, WESTERN DISTRICT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 4.00 p.m. on 8 November 2017 to 4.00 p.m. on 8 December 2017, the northern kerbside of Queen's Road West from a point about 30 metres east of its junction with New Street to a point about 75 metres west of the same junction will continue to be temporarily designated as a restricted zone from 7.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

(a) picking up or setting down passengers; or

(b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zone on the above road section will be rescinded.
