

**RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519)  
(Notice under section 23)**

**SHATIN TO CENTRAL LINK**

**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING  
PERMANENT CLOSURE OF PARTS OF  
TSZ WAN SHAN ESTATE CENTRAL PLAYGROUND AND  
TSZ WAN SHAN ROAD REST GARDEN; STAIRCASES AT  
TSZ WAN SHAN ESTATE CENTRAL PLAYGROUND, AND  
SECTIONS OF WAN WAH STREET AND LUNG POON STREET; AND  
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PART OF  
TSZ WAN SHAN ESTATE CENTRAL PLAYGROUND**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 2 November 2017 (the 'Order'), authorized:-

- (I) (a) the permanent closure of parts of Tsz Wan Shan Estate Central Playground, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plan numbered SCL/G10/0009/11;
- (b) the permanent closure of parts of Tsz Wan Shan Road Rest Garden, as delineated and shown in dark green on the Plan numbered SCL/G10/0009/11;
- (c) the permanent closure of two staircases at Tsz Wan Shan Estate Central Playground, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered SCL/G10/0009/11;
- (d) the permanent closure of part of the footpath widths of the section of Wan Wah Street at a point about 20 metres north of its junction with Yuk Wah Street, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered SCL/G10/0009/11; and
- (e) the permanent closure of part of the footpath widths of the section of Lung Poon Street near its junction with Tai Hom Road, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered SCL/G11/0016/6,

with effect from 29 November 2017; and

- (II) the temporary closure of part of Tsz Wan Shan Estate Central Playground, as delineated and shown in dark blue on the Plan numbered SCL/G10/0009/11 during the period from 29 November to 31 December 2017,

for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the areas of parts of Tsz Wan Shan Estate Central Playground and Tsz Wan Shan Road Rest Garden, the staircases and the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plans numbered SCL/G10/0009/11 and SCL/G11/0016/6 (the 'Plans') may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:–

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near Tsz Wan Shan Estate Central Playground, Tsz Wan Shan Road Rest Garden, the staircases and the roads affected by the Order on 10 November 2017.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of Tsz Wan Shan Estate Central Playground, Tsz Wan Shan Road Rest Garden, the staircases and the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of Tsz Wan Shan Estate Central Playground, Tsz Wan Shan Road Rest Garden, the staircases and the roads affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of Tsz Wan Shan Estate Central Playground or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

## SCHEDULE

*Tsz Wan Shan Estate Central Playground, Tsz Wan Shan Road Rest Garden, the staircases and the roads to be affected*

*Description of the works and the manner in which Tsz Wan Shan Estate Central Playground, Tsz Wan Shan Road Rest Garden, the staircases and the roads will be affected*

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- (a) Parts of Tsz Wan Shan Estate Central Playground, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plan numbered SCL/G10/0009/11.
- Parts of Tsz Wan Shan Estate Central Playground will be permanently closed for the provision of the pedestrian walkway system in relation to the Shatin to Central Link.
- (b) Parts of Tsz Wan Shan Road Rest Garden, as delineated and shown in dark green on the Plan numbered SCL/G10/0009/11.
- Parts of Tsz Wan Shan Road Rest Garden will be permanently closed for the provision of the pedestrian walkway system in relation to the Shatin to Central Link.
- (c) Two staircases at Tsz Wan Shan Estate Central Playground, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered SCL/G10/0009/11.
- The staircases will be permanently closed for the provision of the pedestrian walkway system in relation to the Shatin to Central Link.
- (d) Part of the footpath widths of the section of Wan Wah Street at a point about 20 metres north of its junction with Yuk Wah Street, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered SCL/G10/0009/11.
- Part of the footpath widths will be permanently closed for the provision of the pedestrian walkway system in relation to the Shatin to Central Link.
- (e) Part of the footpath widths of the section of Lung Poon Street near its junction with Tai Hom Road, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered SCL/G11/0016/6.
- Part of the footpath widths will be permanently closed for the provision of the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link.
- (f) Part of Tsz Wan Shan Estate Central Playground, as delineated and shown in dark blue on the Plan numbered SCL/G10/0009/11.
- Part of Tsz Wan Shan Estate Central Playground will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works.
