FOOTBRIDGE SYSTEM ALONG MONG KOK ROAD AND SAI YEE STREET

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Acting Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has ordered under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance') to close temporarily sections of the existing carriageways and footways to the west of Sai Yeung Choi Street South within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. KH13989B ('the Plan') and described in the scheme annexed thereto. The Plan and scheme were referred to in G.N. 2041 published on 1 May 1998 and 8 May 1998. The Acting Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that from 28 December 2017 to 27 December 2018, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways and footways to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve construction of a covered footbridge with an approximate 8.5 metres clear width across Nathan Road, connecting the existing footbridge to the east of the junction of Nathan Road and Mong Kok Road with two lifts, two sets of escalator and staircase to be constructed to the west of the junction of Nathan Road and Mong Kok Road; and other ancillary works.

This notice will be affixed on or near the affected carriageways and footways on 15 December 2017.
