

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES AT PITT STREET, YAU MA TEI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from the following periods, the following sections at Pitt Street will be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

*From 10.00 a.m. on 18 December 2017 to 21 December 2017*

the section of Pitt Street from its junction with Canton Road to a point about 45 metres west of the same junction;

*From 10.00 a.m. on 22 December 2017 to 25 December 2017*

the section of Pitt Street from a point about 15 metres west of its junction with Canton Road to a point about 60 metres west of the same junction;

*From 10.00 a.m. on 27 December 2017 to 30 December 2017*

the section of Pitt Street from its junction with Canton Road to a point about 40 metres west of the same junction;

*From 8.00 a.m. on 6 January 2018 to 8 January 2018*

the section of Pitt Street from its junction with Tak Cheong Street to a point about 45 metres east of the same junction; and

*From 8.00 a.m. on 13 January 2018 to 15 January 2018*

the section of Pitt Street from its junction with Tak Cheong Street to a point about 45 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
