

PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 138)

DIRECTION MADE BY THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE OF  
THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Committee appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, Chapter 138, Laws of Hong Kong ('the Ordinance') to inquire into the conduct of an authorized seller of poisons, namely Ying Kwok Dispensary, at Ground Floor, 272 Lockhart Road, Wan Chai, Hong Kong, has conducted an inquiry on 16 November 2017 in accordance with section 16 of the Ordinance.

The said Committee was satisfied after the inquiry that Ying Kwok Dispensary had been guilty of misconduct in that at the material time, Mr. YEUNG Che-cho (being the sole-proprietor) of Ying Kwok Dispensary, an authorized seller of poisons, was convicted of the following offence under the Trade Descriptions Ordinance (Cap. 362, Laws of Hong Kong) on 14 March 2017 at Eastern Magistrates' Courts for which the following order was imposed on 3 April 2017:—

It is further notified that under section 16(2)(b) of the Ordinance, the said Committee directed that Ying Kwok Dispensary should be disqualified from being an authorized seller of poisons for a period of 3 days with effect from 29 December 2017. The said Committee added that its direction should be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
