LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ORDINANCE (Chapter 159)

ORDER THAT A BARRISTER BE SUSPENDED FROM PRACTISING  
LAU SAI LUK

In accordance with section 37A(2) of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Chapter 159), I hereby give notice that on the 28th day of November 2017 a Barristers Disciplinary Tribunal ('the Tribunal') found two complaints against LAU Sai Luk ('Mr. LAU') proved. The complaints were that Mr. LAU acted in contrary to paragraphs 4, 6(b), 7 and 10(a) of the Code of Conduct of the Bar of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.

The Tribunal ordered that:—

- (i) Mr. LAU be suspended from practicing as a barrister for a period of 1 month on each proven complaint, to be served concurrently, and to take effect from the date of publication by the Bar Council by way of a Bar circular and on the Bar's website in the part which is accessible only by members of the Bar. The publication shall be made within 14 days from the expiration of the period of appeal against, or judicial review of the order; and
- (ii) Mr. LAU shall pay the Bar Council costs of HK\$200,000, to be complied with within 28 days from the date of publication by the Bar Council.

The Order of the Tribunal dated 28 November 2017 was filed with the Registrar on the 19th day of December 2017.
