PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 138)

DIRECTION MADE BY THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE OF THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Committee appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, Chapter 138, Laws of Hong Kong ('the Ordinance') to inquire into the conduct of an authorized seller of poisons, namely San Lung Fung Dispensary O/B Lung Fung Dispensary (3rd Store) Limited, at Flat B and Cockloft, Flat C and Cockloft, Flat D, Flat E, Ground Floor, 113–119 San Fung Avenue, Sheung Shui, New Territories, has conducted an inquiry on 23 November 2017 in accordance with section 16 of the Ordinance.

The said Committee was satisfied after the inquiry that San Lung Fung Dispensary O/B Lung Fung Dispensary (3rd Store) Limited had been guilty of misconduct in that at the material time, Lung Fung Dispensary (3rd Store) operating San Lung Fung Dispensary, an authorized seller of poisons and its director cum person-in-charge, Mr. CHEN Ming-shui, Eugene, were convicted of the following offences under the Ordinance on 25 May 2017 at Fanling Magistrates' Courts for which the following order was imposed:—

It is further notified that under section 16(2)(b) of the Ordinance, the said Committee directed that San Lung Fung Dispensary O/B Lung Fung Dispensary (3rd Store) Limited should be disqualified from being an authorized seller of poisons for a period of 21 days with effect from 5 January 2018. The said Committee added that its direction should be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
