TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has ordered under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works. Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance') to close permanently sections of the existing carriageways and footpaths of Sha Ling Road and Man Kam To Road; and temporarily sections of existing carriageways and footpaths of Sha Ling Road and Man Kam To Road within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 231448/GAZ-A/001, 231448/GAZ-A/002 and 231448/GAZ-A/003 (except limit of works area of Sha Ling Road and Man Kam To Road adjoining the proposed Road C shown on the Plan) ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, and as amended by Amendment Plans Nos. 231448/GAZ-A/101 to 231448/GAZ-A/103 ('the Amendment Plans') and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto. The Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 1834 published on 27 February 2015 and 6 March 2015. The Amendment Plans and amendment scheme were referred to in G.N. 9724 published on 18 December 2015 and 24 December 2015. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that as from 13 January 2018, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the resisting carriageways and footpaths to be permanently closed, shall be extinguished; and from 13 January 2018 to 12 January 2019, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways and footpaths to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve widening of Sha Ling Road including the construction of carriageways, footpaths, central medians/traffic islands, vertical noise barriers and slope works, construction of a pick-up/drop-off point at Man Kam To Road, and other ancillary works.
