

The Lands Department announced today (October 22) the proposed letting of three sites in the New Territories by short term tenancy to the brownfield operators affected by the First Phase Development of Kwu Tung North/Fanling North New Development Areas, First Phase Development of Hung Shui Kiu/Ha Tsuen New Development Area, Public Housing Developments at Kam Tin South, First Phase of Public Housing Development at Wang Chau, Public Housing Developments at Long Bin and Development of Lok Ma Chau Loop—Main Works Package 1.
