

PROTECTION OF WAGES ON INSOLVENCY ORDINANCE (Chapter 380)

(Notice of payment and reasons therefore
given pursuant to section 16(1A))

Notice is given pursuant to section 16(1A) of the Protection of Wages on Insolvency Ordinance (Chapter 380) that I have made an *ex gratia* payment of \$2,131.00 out of the Protection of Wages on Insolvency Fund under section 16(1)(a)(ii) of that Ordinance to SHEW Tsz Suet ('the Employee'), the former employee(s) of WONG Tsz Yan ('the Employer') of Shop G36, G/F, Argyle Centre Phase 1, 65 Argyle Street and 688 Nathan Road, Mong Kok, Kowloon, Shop 303, 3/F, New Town Mall, 65 Argyle Street, Mong Kok, Kowloon and Room 4010, Sau Ching House, Sau Mau Ping Estate, 101 Sau Ming Road, Kwun Tong, Kowloon, the reasons for the payment being that it appeared to me that the Employer had failed to pay wages, or pay for untaken annual leave, or pay for untaken statutory holidays, or wages in lieu of notice, or severance payment, or all or any of them due to the Employee and would, but for the existence of section 6(2)(a) of the Bankruptcy Ordinance (Chapter 6), be liable to have a bankruptcy petition presented against her.
