## MEDICAL REGISTRATION ORDINANCE (Chapter 161)

## ORDER MADE BY THE MEDICAL COUNCIL OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that the Medical Council of Hong Kong after due inquiry held on 27 January 2005 in accordance with section 21 of the Medical Registration Ordinance, Chapter 161 of the Laws of Hong Kong, was satisfied that in the period between July and August 2002 Dr. TSE Ka-ming, being a registered medical practitioner sent a document titled 'St. Teresa's Hospital PET Scan Department: Case Presentation', which was prepared by him and which contained gratuitous and unsustainable comments about a registered medical practitioner Dr. YAU Yat-yin's knowledge or skill, to a number of registered medical practitioners including oncologists, general practitioners and superintendents of hospitals; and such acts undermined the trust of Dr. YAU Yat-yin's knowledge or skill by her professional colleagues with reference to section 19.3 of the Professional Code and Conduct.

The Council was satisfied that in relation to the facts alleged, Dr. TSE has been guilty of misconduct in a professional respect.

In accordance with section 21(1)(iii) of the said Ordinance, the Council ordered on 27 January 2005 that Dr. TSE Ka-ming would be reprimanded. Such decision would be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette.
