LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ORDINANCE (Chapter 159)

ORDER THAT A BARRISTER BE SUSPENDED FROM PRACTISING MR. LAW TAT HUNG, LAWRENCE

In accordance with section 37A of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Chapter 159), I hereby give notice that on 26 September 2005 a Barristers Disciplinary Tribunal found the complaints against Mr. LAW Tat Hung, Lawrence of misconduct proved.

The complaints were that Mr. LAW Tat Hung, Lawrence acted contrary to the provisions of paragraphs 7 and 10(a) of the Code of Conduct of the Bar of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.

The Tribunal ordered that:—

- (1) Mr. LAW Tat Hung, Lawrence be suspended from practicing as a barrister for a period of 2 months for First Complaint;
- (2) He be suspended from practising as a barrister for a period of 2 months for Second Complaint;
- (3) The suspensions mentioned in (1) and (2) above are to run concurrently;

The Tribunal also ordered that he pay costs of HK\$30,000.
