LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ORDINANCE (Chapter 159)

ORDER THAT A BARRISTER BE SUSPENDED FROM PRACTISING MR. LAWRENCE T. H. LAW

In accordance with section 37A of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Chapter 159), I hereby give notice that a Barristers Disciplinary Tribunal, on 21 May 2007, found LAW Tat Hung, Lawrence also known as Lawrence T. H. LAW guilty of three complaints of misconduct contrary to paragraph 6 and in breach of paragraph 100 of the Code of Conduct of the Bar of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.

On 12 June 2007 the Tribunal ordered that Lawrence T. H. LAW be censured, he be suspended from practising as a barrister for a period of 4 months in relation to the 3rd Complaint and he shall pay the costs in the amount of \$189,306.
