The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:-----

- (i) realignment of Concorde Road carriageway and footpaths and construction of a roundabout at the end of the realigned Concorde Road;
- (ii) construction of Roads L2, L3, L4 and L15 of approximately 2 kilometres long in total;
- (iii) extension and widening of Kai Wah Street carriageway and footpath;
- (iv) construction of a subway extension of approximately 40 metres (m) long connecting the existing subway under San Po Kong Interchange and the future government offices;
- (v) construction of a footbridge of approximately 170 m long connecting the future government offices and a future development at San Po Kong;
- (vi) construction of a footbridge of approximately 85 m long connecting Eastern Road and Rhythm Garden;
- (vii) permanent closure of Cargo Circuit carriageways and footpaths;
- (viii) permanent closure and demolition of sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, ramps and staircase;
 - (ix) temporary closure of sections of the existing carriageways and footpaths; and
 - (x) ancillary works including drainage, water, utility and landscaping works.
