

FORESHORE AND SEA-BED (RECLAMATIONS) ORDINANCE (Chapter 127)
(Notice of Authorization under section 9)

PROPOSED SUPPLEMENTARY SEAWATER PUMPING STATION
AT BLACK POINT POWER STATION,
TUEN MUN, NEW TERRITORIES

It is hereby notified that the undertaking in relation to the foreshore and sea-bed described in the Schedule below as mentioned in G.N. 333 published under section 5 on 18 January 2013 and 25 January 2013 was authorized under section 7 by the Chief Executive on 15 April 2013.

Any person who considers that he has an interest, right or easement in or over such foreshore and sea-bed that will be injuriously affected by the undertaking may deliver a written claim for compensation for the injurious affection to the Director of Lands, 20th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before the expiration of 1 year from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*, stating the sum of money which he is willing to accept in full and final settlement of his claim together with such particulars as he may possess to substantiate the claim.

SCHEDULE

Foreshore and sea-bed affected

Approximately 2 853.5 square metres of foreshore and sea-bed situated at the shore of Black Point Power Station, Tuen Mun as delineated and shown edged red on a plan, numbered TMM3443b, deposited in the Land Registry.

Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking

Construction of a seawater intake box culvert of approximately 13.5 metres in width and 27 metres in length extending from the existing seawall at the shore of Black Point Power Station. The existing seawall will be temporarily removed and will be reinstated to the original profile upon completion of works. Approximately 50 metres by 50 metres area of sea-bed in front of the seawater intake box culvert will be dredged down to approximately 1 metre below the existing level to facilitate intake of seawater.
