**INSPECTION OF THE 2013 PROVISIONAL REGISTER
AND THE OMISSIONS LIST**

Pursuant to sections 10 and 13 of the Electoral Affairs Commission (Registration of Electors) (Legislative Council Geographical Constituencies) (District Council Constituencies) Regulation (hereinafter referred to 'the Regulation'), it is hereby notified that -

- (a) the provisional register of electors for geographical constituencies and the District Council (second) functional constituency; and
- (b) the omissions list for geographical constituencies and the District Council (second) functional constituency containing the names and principal residential addresses of persons who are no longer eligible to be registered in the geographical constituencies and the District Council (second) functional constituency register,

are now available for public inspection during ordinary business hours from Monday to Friday from 14 to 29 June 2013. The places for inspection are as follows -

- (t) Any of the places under items (a) to (s) above.

A person who considers that a registered person is not eligible to be registered as an elector or be registered in the section or the subsection in which that person's name and principal residential address are recorded may, under section 14 of the Regulation, lodge in person¹ at the office of the Electoral Registration Officer not later than 29 June 2013 a notice of objection in the specified form. The address of the office of the Electoral Registration Officer is set out in the form.

Any person who has made an application for registration but whose name is not recorded in the provisional register or whose name is included in the omissions list, or who has a claim regarding his particulars in the provisional register may, under section 15 of the Regulation, lodge in person² at the office of the Electoral Registration Officer not later than 29 June 2013 a notice of claim in the specified form. The address of the office of the Electoral Registration Officer is set out in the form.
