

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in duplicate are invited for **Contract No. GE/2013/29, Landslip Prevention and Mitigation Programme, 2010 Package G and 2011 Package C**, Landslip Prevention and Mitigation Works in Kowloon and the New Territories. The works include upgrading of some 35 government slopes and retaining walls, and natural terrain mitigation works to some 11 natural hillside catchments in Kowloon and the New Territories. The works are scheduled to commence in December 2013 and will take about 30 months to complete.

Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board, and placed in the Government Secretariat Tender Box situated in the lobby of the Public Entrance on the Ground Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong before 12.00 noon on Friday, 4 October 2013. Late tenders will not be accepted.

In the event a tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above or a black rainstorm warning signal is in force between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 4 October 2013, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the first working day of the following week. An announcement of the change will be made through the radio.

Contractors on the List of Approved Suppliers of Materials and Specialist Contractors for Public Works—Landslip Preventive/Remedial Works to Slopes/Retaining Walls are invited to tender. Contractors will be liable to have their names removed from the approved list if they fail or refuse to implement an accepted tender.
