

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in triplicate are invited for the **Triennial Contract for Maintenance and Repair of, Alterations and Additions to, Fire Service Installations for Municipal Venues in Kowloon for the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (Tender Reference: 1065EM13T)**. The tentative contract commencement date is 1 February 2014 and the tentative contract completion date is 31 January 2016.
