CREATION OF RIGHTS OF TEMPORARY OCCUPATION OF LAND

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, the Deputy Director/Specialist, Lands Department has made an order under section 15(1) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (hereinafter referred to as 'the Ordinance') directing that the rights of temporary occupation of the land known and registered in the Land Registry as the Remaining Portion of Chek Lap Kok Lot No. 1 and the Extension Thereto (Portion) at the location as indicated and shown hatched black on the Plan For Creation Of Rights Of Temporary Occupation Of Land No. ISM1732b-IIa annexed to the said order, which land was described in the scheme referred to in Government Notice No. 4891 published on 7 August 2009 and 14 August 2009 with amendments as described in Government Notice No. 1151 published on 2 March 2012 and 9 March 2012 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Scheme') for a period from the expiry of the period of notice as hereinafter mentioned to 31 December 2017 be created in favour of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region for the purposes of or incidental to the works or use described in the Scheme.

The Deputy Director/Specialist, Lands Department has under section 15(3) of the Ordinance further directed that subject to the serving of any notice required to be given under section 15(5) of the Ordinance, the Director of Highways, his contractors, employees, servants, agents, licensees and any other persons authorized or permitted by the Director of Highways be given full rights and liberty to enter upon the said land for the purposes of carrying out any operations or installing, maintaining or removing any structures or apparatus in connection with the Scheme.

A copy of the said order and a copy of the aforesaid Plan No. ISM1732b-IIa may be inspected by members of the public, free of charge, at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing before the expiration of one year from the date on which the aforesaid rights are created.
