RESUMPTION OF UNDERGROUND STRATA OF LAND

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Deputy Director of Lands/Specialist has made an order under section 16 of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) (hereinafter referred to as 'the Ordinance') directing that the underground strata in respect of the land more particularly described in the first column below and between the levels specified in the second column below:—

New Kowloon Inland Lot No. 6186	Between the level of 1.3 metres below P.D. and the level of 26.6 metres below P.D.

as shown coloured blue stippled black on Underground Strata Resumption Plan No. RDM1567 (Sheets 1 to 3) annexed to the said order, which underground strata of land was described in the scheme referred to in Government Notice No. 7301 published on 26 November 2010 and 3 December 2010, as amended by Government Notice No. 4423 published on 15 July 2011 and 22 July 2011, and as amended and corrected under Government Notice No. 7326 published on 11 November 2011 and 18 November 2011, and as modified by Government Notice No. 2368 published on 13 April 2012 and 20 April 2012 shall be resumed.

The above scheme has been authorized by the Chief Executive in Council and such authorization was gazetted in Government Notice No. 2368 published on 13 April 2012 and 20 April 2012.

This notice was affixed on or near the said land on 4 November 2013.

The Deputy Director of Lands/Specialist has under section 18(1) of the Ordinance specified a period of notice of THREE MONTHS from the date upon which this notice was affixed on or near the said land and upon expiry of that period, the underground strata in respect of the said land shall by virtue of section 18(2) of the Ordinance revert to the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region for the purposes of or incidental to the scheme.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing before expiration of one year from the date of resumption.
