

ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)

CREATION OF RIGHTS OF TEMPORARY OCCUPATION OF LAND FOR
CENTRAL—WAN CHAI BYPASS AND ISLAND EASTERN CORRIDOR LINK

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, the Deputy Director/Specialist, Lands Department has made an order under section 15(1) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (interpreted in accordance with the provisions of the Hong Kong Reunification Ordinance No. 110 of 1997 and hereinafter referred to as 'the Ordinance') directing that rights of temporary occupation in a portion of the land known and registered in the Land Registry as section A of Inland Lot No. 7106 and Extension thereto below the level of 12 metres above the Hong Kong Principal Datum as shown coloured purple stippled black on the Plan No. HKM8529a annexed to the said order be created for a period from the 26th day of February 2014 to the 31st day of May 2017, which land was described in the scheme referred to in Government Notice No. 4767 published on 27 July 2007 and 3 August 2007 as amended by Government Notice No. 8202 published on 5 December 2008 and 12 December 2008 in favour of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region for the purposes of or incidental to the works or use described in the said scheme.

The Deputy Director/Specialist, Lands Department has under section 15(3) of the Ordinance further directed that subject to the serving of any notice required to be given under section 15(5) of the Ordinance, the Director of Highways, his officers, workmen, servants and contractors and any persons authorized by the Director of Highways are authorized to enter upon the said portion of land for the purposes of carrying out any operations or installing, maintaining or removing any structures or apparatus in connection with the said scheme.

The Deputy Director/Specialist, Lands Department has under section 15(2) of the Ordinance specified a period of notice of THREE MONTHS from the date upon which this notice was affixed on or near the said portion of land and it is hereby declared upon expiry of that period, the aforesaid rights shall by virtue of section 15(4) of the Ordinance be created in favour of the

Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region for the purposes of or incidental to the works or use described above in the said scheme.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing before the expiration of one year from the date on which the aforesaid rights are created.
