TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, the Deputy Director/Specialist, Lands Department has made an order under section 13(1) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (interpreted in accordance with the provisions of the Hong Kong Reunification Ordinance No. 110 of 1997 and hereinafter referred to as 'the Ordinance') directing that all that piece of land known and registered in the Land Registry as The Remaining Portion of New Kowloon Inland Lot No. 5994 (Portion) as shown coloured orange hatched black on Plan No. KM8891a annexed to the said order, which said piece of land was described in the scheme referred to in Government Notice No. 4589 published on 9 August 2013 and 16 August 2013 shall be resumed.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing before the expiration of one year from the date of resumption.
