

## ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)

(Notice under section 14)

ROAD WORKS AT KENNEDY ROAD, QUEEN'S ROAD EAST  
AND SHIP STREET, WAN CHAI, HONG KONG

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, the Deputy Director/Specialist, Lands Department has made an order under section 13(1) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (interpreted in accordance with the provisions of the Hong Kong Reunification Ordinance No. 110 of 1997 and hereinafter referred to as 'the Ordinance') directing that the land known and registered in the Land Registry as Inland Lot No. 7254 (Portion) as shown coloured orange hatched black on the Resumption PLAN No. HKM8334 annexed to the said order, which land was described in the scheme referred to in G.N. No. 2152 published on 9 April 2009 and 17 April 2009 shall be resumed.

The Deputy Director/Specialist, Lands Department has under Section 13(2) of the Ordinance specified a period of notice of THREE CALENDAR MONTHS from the date upon which this notice was affixed on or near the land and upon expiry of that period the land described above shall by virtue of section 13(3) of the Ordinance revert to the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region for the purposes of or incidental to the works or use described in the said scheme.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing before the expiration of one year from the date of resumption.
