CREATION OF RIGHTS OF TEMPORARY OCCUPATION OF LAND FOR
PWP ITEM NO. 566CL—
DEVELOPMENT AT ANDERSON ROAD—ANCILLARY ROAD WORKS

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, the Deputy Director/Specialist, Lands Department has made an order under section 15(1) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (interpreted in accordance with the provisions of the Hong Kong Reunification Ordinance No. 110 of 1997 and hereinafter referred to as 'the Ordinance') directing that rights of temporary occupation for a further period commencing from 1 January 2016 (i.e. the expiry of the period referred to in Government Notice No. 6505 dated 6 October 2011) to 31 December 2016 be created over all those pieces or parcels of land known and registered in the Land Registry as:—

as shown coloured purple stippled black on Plan No. KM8064b annexed to the said order ('the Plan') which said pieces or parcels of land were described in the amendment scheme referred to in Government Notice No. 7307 published on 27 November 2009 and 4 December 2009.

The Deputy Director/Specialist, Lands Department has under section 15(3) of the Ordinance further directed that subject to the serving of any notice required to be given under section 15(5) of the Ordinance, the Director of Civil Engineering and Development, his officers, workmen, servants, contractors and any persons authorized by the Director of Civil Engineering and Development shall be authorized to enter upon the said pieces or parcels of land for the purposes of carrying out any operations or installing, maintaining or removing any structures or apparatus in connection with the said amendment scheme.

The Deputy Director/Specialist, Lands Department has under section 15(2) of the Ordinance specified a period of notice starting from 30 September 2015 upon which this notice was affixed on or near the said pieces or parcels of land and expiring at mid-night on 31 December 2015 and it is hereby declared upon expiry of that period, the rights of temporary occupation over the said pieces or parcels of land shall by virtue of section 15(4) of the Ordinance be created in favour of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region for the purposes of or incidental to the works or use described in the said amendment scheme.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong before the expiration of one year from the date on which the rights of temporary occupation are created.

Personal Information Collection Statement

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Secretary for Transport and Housing in connection with any written claims served under section 29 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) will be used for the processing of the claims and other related purposes. The provision of the information, including the personal data, as required under section 29 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) is obligatory. If such information, including the personal data, as required under section 29 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) is not provided as requested, the claims may be rejected. Any information, including the personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other organizations or agencies which are required to handle the claims and related matters. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to and correction of their personal data in relation to their claims. Request for access to or correction of the personal data should be made in writing to the Personal Data Privacy Officer of the Transport and Housing Bureau (Transport Branch) at 20th Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong.
