ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)

DEVELOPMENT OF ANDERSON ROAD QUARRY SITE—  
ROAD IMPROVEMENT WORKS—PACKAGE 1

Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 60328348/GAZ\_RIW/121 and 60328348/GAZ\_RIW/122 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) widening of a section of the New Clear Water Bay Road westbound (Kowloon bound) near Shun Lee Tsuen Road from one lane to two lanes;
- (ii) modification and realignment of sections of the existing slip roads connecting Shun Lee Tsuen Road and New Clear Water Bay Road;
- (iii) modification of the existing junctions at Clear Water Bay Road/ On Sau Road and at New Clear Water Bay Road/ Clear Water Bay Road, and construction of a U-turn facility at Clear Water Bay Road;
- (iv) construction of carriageways, footpaths, central reserves/refuge islands and verges;
- (v) construction of a noise enclosure and cantilever noise barriers at New Clear Water Bay Road;
- (vi) construction of a semi-enclosure and a cantilever noise barrier at Clear Water Bay Road;
- (vii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing at grade carriageways into footpath, central reserves/refuge islands and verge;
- (viii) permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing elevated carriageway into central reserve/refuge island;
- (ix) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing footpaths into at grade carriageways and verges;
- (x) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing central reserves/refuge islands into at grade carriageways;
- (xi) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing verges into at grade carriageways, footpath and central reserve/refuge island;
- (xii) permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing staircase into subway;
- (xiii) temporary closure and modification of sections of the existing at grade carriageways, elevated carriageway, footpaths, central reserves/refuge islands, verges and staircase; and
- (xiv) ancillary works including construction of retaining walls and slopes, as well as drainage, water, utilities, slope stabilization, street lighting and landscaping works.

Objectors are requested to provide contact details to the Secretary to facilitate communication.
