Approximately a total of 1 270 square metres of foreshore and sea-bed situated near River Silver in Mui Wo as delineated and shown edged red on a plan, numbered ISM2564b, deposited in the Land Registry.

Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking

The drainage improvement works in Mui Wo involve extension of the existing riverwall at River Silver by approximately 40 metres long.
