

KAI TAK CRUISE TERMINAL ORDINANCE (Chapter 627)

Notice under section 9

DESIGNATION OF PERMANENT AND NON-PERMANENT
RESTRICTED AREAS WITHIN THE TERMINAL AREA
OF THE KAI TAK CRUISE TERMINAL

Pursuant to section 9 of the Kai Tak Cruise Terminal Ordinance (Ord. No. 19 of 2016), I hereby designate the areas described in Schedule 1 below as permanent restricted areas and the areas described in Schedule 2 below as non-permanent restricted areas within the Terminal Area of the Kai Tak Cruise Terminal.

permanent restricted areas	The areas on land or inside the building of the Kai Tak Cruise Terminal within the Terminal Area, as delineated and shown shaded pink on the plans, numbered KTCTB/201506/01, KTCTB/201506/02 and KTCTB/201506/03, deposited in the office of the Commissioner for Tourism.
