

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CHANGE STREET NAME

Notice is hereby given under section 111C of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance, Chapter 132, that the Director of Lands intends to make a declaration to rename a section of HAMMER HILL ROAD as set out in G.N. 1872 dated 28 July 1972 in the district of Wong Tai Sin, Kowloon as a section of LUNG CHEUNG ROAD and to cease a section of HAMMER HILL ROAD inside the Diamond Hill Urn Cemetery as set out in G.N. 1468 dated 16 November 1956 to be known by that name as described hereunder:—

The road is approximately 130 metres long. It extends from the existing Lung Cheung Road near the northern corner of Choi Hung Estate and ends at its junction with Choi Hung Road. Its location and alignment are more particularly shown coloured pink on Plan No. KRM98.	LUNG CHEUNG ROAD
The road is approximately 130 metres long. It starts from the southern corner of Diamond Hill Urn Cemetery and ends at a <i>cul-de-sac</i> . Its location and alignment are more particularly shown coloured pink on Plan No. KRM97.	HAMMER HILL ROAD
