TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, the Deputy Director/Specialist, Lands Department has made an order under section 13(1) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (hereinafter referred to as 'the Ordinance') directing that all those pieces or parcels of land in North District, New Territories more particularly described below:—

Lots Nos. 551 S.B RP (Portion) and 554 S.A RP (Portion) all in Demarcation District No. 89 and shown coloured orange stippled black on the Resumption Plan No. DNM3117a annexed to the said order, which land was described in the scheme referred to in Government Notice No. 1834 published on 27 February 2015 and 6 March 2015 and as amended by Government Notice No. 9724 published on 18 December 2015 and 24 December 2015, shall be resumed.

affixed on or near the said land and upon expiry of that period the land described above shall by virtue of section 13(3) of the Ordinance revert to the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region for the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use described in the said scheme.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing a written claim, which can be submitted via one of the following means, before the expiration of one year from the date of resumption:—

Personal Information Collection Statement

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Secretary for Transport and Housing in connection with any written claims served under section 29 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) will be used for the processing of the claims and other related purposes.
