

FORESHORE AND SEA-BED (RECLAMATIONS) ORDINANCE (Chapter 127)

(Notice of authorization under section 9)

**PROPOSED PACIFIC LIGHT CABLE NETWORK
FROM DEEP WATER BAY TO THE EASTERN BOUNDARY
OF THE HONG KONG SPECIAL ADMINISTRATIVE REGION**

It is hereby notified that the undertaking in relation to the foreshore and sea-bed described in the Schedule below as mentioned in G.N. 7571 published under section 5 on 13 October 2017 and 20 October 2017 was authorized under section 7 on 10 January 2018.

Any person who considers that he has an interest, right or easement in or over such foreshore and sea-bed that will be injuriously affected by the undertaking may deliver a written claim for compensation for the injurious affection to the Director of Lands, 20th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before the expiration of 1 year from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*, stating the sum of money which he is willing to accept in full and final settlement of his claim together with such particulars as he may possess to substantiate the claim.

SCHEDULE

Foreshore and sea-bed affected

Approximately 2.19 hectares of foreshore and sea-bed from Deep Water Bay to the eastern boundary of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region as delineated and shown by a bold red line on a plan, numbered HKM10130, deposited in the Land Registry.

Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking

- (i) Installation of a submarine optical fibre cable of approximately 39.8 kilometres in length and 100 millimetres in diameter by divers and jet-ploughing/jetting technique.
- (ii) The submarine optical fibre cable will be buried in a narrow trench of approximately 0.5 metre in width at a target depth of approximately 5 metres below the sea-bed.

Foreshore and sea-bed affected

Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking

- (iii) Where the submarine optical fibre cable crosses the existing telecommunications cables, it will be shallow buried (with articulated pipe/'Ureduct'/other similar protection).
- (iv) Where the submarine optical fibre cable crosses the existing gas pipeline, it will be surface laid and/or shallow buried within a distance of approximately 100 metres centred on the crossing point. If necessary, the submarine optical fibre cable may be protected by 'Ureduct' or an optional cable protection using concrete mattress/grout bags/rock dumping of a maximum width of 20 metres.

Personal Information Collection Statement

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Director of Lands in connection with any written claims served under section 12(1) of the Foreshore and Sea-bed (Reclamations) Ordinance (Chapter 127) will be used for the processing of the claims and other related purposes. The provision of the information, including the personal data, as required under section 12(1) of the Foreshore and Sea-bed (Reclamations) Ordinance (Chapter 127) is obligatory. If such information, including the personal data, as required under section 12(1) of the Foreshore and Sea-bed (Reclamations) Ordinance (Chapter 127) is not provided as requested, the claims may be rejected. Any information, including the personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other organizations or agencies which are required to handle the claims and related matters. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to and correction of their personal data held by us.
