**Hazardous Chemicals Control Ordinance (Amendment of
Schedule 2) Order 2018**

(Made by the Secretary for the Environment under section 50(1) of the
Hazardous Chemicals Control Ordinance (Cap. 595))

1. Commencement

This Order comes into operation on 1 July 2018.

2. Hazardous Chemicals Control Ordinance amended

The Hazardous Chemicals Control Ordinance (Cap. 595) is
amended as set out in section 3.

Explanatory Note

The Hazardous Chemicals Control Ordinance (Cap. 595) (***Ordinance***) regulates the manufacture, export, import and use of certain hazardous chemicals. These chemicals are specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to the Ordinance, and include those subject to the regulation of the Rotterdam Convention on the Prior Informed Consent Procedure for Certain Hazardous Chemicals and Pesticides in International Trade (***Rotterdam Convention***).

2. The list of chemicals subject to the regulation of the Rotterdam Convention has been amended. Correspondingly, this Order amends Schedule 2 to the Ordinance to update the list of chemicals regulated by the Ordinance.
