## TELECOMMUNICATIONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 106)

Pursuant to section 7C(4) of the Telecommunications Ordinance, the Communications Authority ('CA') hereby gives notice on its proposal to vary the Class Licence for Short Range Device ('Class Licence') to expand its scope to cover:—

- (a) the possession and use of short range devices employing ultra-wideband ('UWB') technology and operating within the 4.2–4.8 GHz and 6–8.5 GHz bands ('UWB devices'), in addition to short range devices operating within the 433–434.79 MHz band ('433 MHz devices') which are covered in the current version of the Class Licence; and
- (b) trading activities in respect of the UWB devices and the 433 MHz devices.
