Late tenders will not be accepted. If a Black Rainstorm Warning Signal or Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above is hoisted at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on 10 December 2018, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the first working day after the Black Rainstorm Warning Signal has ceased to be in effect or the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 is lowered.

Open tendering is adopted. All interested contractors/suppliers/service providers are invited to tender.
