## **SCHEDULE**

## Foreshore and sea-bed affected

Approximately 0.51 hectare of foreshore and sea-bed situated at Po Toi O as delineated and shown edged red on a plan, numbered SKM9454, deposited in the Land Registry.

Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking

The proposed works include:—

- (i) Construction of a submarine outfall of about 385 metres in length from the shore by horizontal directional drilling at a depth of up to 30 metres below the sea-bed. Dredging of sea-bed is not required, except the end section of the outfall; and
- (ii) Erection of a temporary works area at the end section of the submarine outfall to facilitate excavation and installation of the diffuser.
