Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 380288/GP/01, 380288/GP/02 and 380288/GP/03 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:----

- (i) construction of a section of a dual carriageway (Road D1) connecting to the existing interchange underneath Kong Sham Western Highway with associated footpaths, verges, central reserves/refuge islands, run-ins/run-outs and signal-controlled pedestrian crossing;
- (ii) construction of a single two-lane carriageway (Road L51) connecting to Kai Pak Ling Road and Road D1 with associated footpaths, verges, central reserve/refuge island and pedestrian crossing;
- (iii) construction of a section of a single two-lane carriageway (Road L54) connecting to Fung Kong Tsuen Road with associated footpaths, verges, central reserve/refuge island, run-ins/ run-outs and pedestrian crossing;
- (iv) widening of a section of Fung Kong Tsuen Road to a single two-lane carriageway with construction of associated footpaths and verges;
- (v) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into footpaths, verges, central reserves/refuge islands, run-in/run-out and pedestrian crossing;
- (vi) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing run-ins/run-outs into carriageways, footpaths and verge;
- (vii) temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing carriageways;
- (viii) temporary closure of sections of the existing carriageways and footpaths; and
- (ix) ancillary works including geotechnical, drainage, sewerage, water, utilities, street lighting, landscaping, and electrical and mechanical works, installation of street furniture and traffic aids, and construction of retaining walls and slopes.
