Approximately 9 670 square metres of foreshore and sea-bed situated at the northern part of Lamma Island as delineated and shown edged red on a plan, numbered ISM2910a, deposited in the Land Registry.

Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking

Reconstruction works include extension of the existing Pak Kok Pier. The suspended deck structure for the proposed extension will be founded on piles and will cover an area of approximately 600 square metres above the sea. Landing steps at the existing pier will be demolished and replaced by seawall blocks.
