Foreshore and sea-bed affected

Approximately 3 200 square metres of foreshore and sea-bed situated at the southern part of the former Kai Tak Airport runway as delineated and shown edged red on a plan, numbered KM10112, deposited in the Land Registry.

Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking

- (i) Construction of permanent seawater outfalls along a section of an existing seawall to support the additional district cooling system at the Kai Tak Development.
- (ii) Reconstruction of the above section of the existing seawall (about 80 metres long).
