

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES ON TING LAI ROAD,  
TAI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.00 p.m. on 4 May 2019 to 6.00 p.m. on 4 June 2019, the following road sections will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Ting Lai Road from a point about 70 metres north of its junction with Ting Kok Road to a point about 150 metres north of the same junction; and
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Ting Lai Road from a point about 15 metres east of its junction with San Wai Tsai Road to a point about 80 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones have been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
